Deadline: This application form and all other required documentation must be received by July 1, 2021. Complete this form and provide to your Teacher or School Counselor. The Fellowship committee will review the application and make the final decision.

Student must meet all of the following requirements in order to be eligible:

- Must have graduated from a Learn4life school and/or be currently enrolled for at least one entire semester with a Learn4Life, FLEX or Stanza school.
- Minimum 2.75 GPA at one of the above schools.
- Letter of recommendation from supervising teacher, counselor or principal.
- Verification from supervising teacher acknowledging the student meets the requirements and can successfully complete the coursework during the 12-week program.*
- Consideration given for special circumstances.
- Student must submit a 1-2-page essay based on the following bullet points below.

The 1-2-page essay should address the following areas:

- Why is this fellowship opportunity important to you?
- Explain your educational and career plans
- Describe any community involvement, and/or volunteer work
- Share your past achievements, aspirations and future goals that make you a good fit for this fellowship
